Artist Application

Join us for the exciting 9th Annual Boerne Art Waddle. Enjoy the flavor of Boerne's neighborhood known as "The Flats" and the historical downtown Hauptstrasse. This is a relaxed fun event with all the attributes of a major fine art event. Self-guided route maps will indicate all artist locations for our record breaking, Covid conscientious break out event this year. Artists will have the opportunity to interact with Waddlers (the public) through art demos and booth chats in their safely spaced assigned areas. Great food, music and activities for all ages. It is GREAT to be back in a big way! Now is the time to stop "Quacking about 2020" and get on board with a renowned group of registered Waddle Artists who will be exhibiting their works for sale and show awards. We have a soft juried process and fee this year to save time.

The Waddle weekend kicks off Friday, May 7th with a Meet the Artists and Gallery Waddle from 4pm – 8pm in conjunction with the downtown merchants, restaurants and breweries. The Boerne Art Waddle goes into full swing on Saturday from 10am – 4pm with various events throughout the day, including a family/kids activity area sponsored by the Cibolo Center for Conservation. Artists can request placement at their prior locations or can be assigned a new area based on availability.

Proceeds go to support:

Scholarships for children to attend the Cibolo Center & Farm Summer Art Camp and Hill Country Council for the Arts.

Fees:

There is a non-refundable jury fee of \$15 plus entry fee of \$40 for a total tax-deductible contribution of \$55 dollars. Your fee also entitles you to hotel discounts at our host hotels and supporting merchants. Any 2019 returning artist can take a 50% discount on the jury fee. All checks or money orders to be made out to: Hill Country Council for the Arts and mailed with application.

Eligible Media:

Prints and Giclée's are permitted, but a minimum of 50% of the displayed artwork must be original work.

To enter, your medium must fall into one on the following Fine Art categories:

- 1) Acrylics / Oils
- 2) Watercolor
- 3) Pastels, Pencil, Pen & Ink
- 4) Photography
- 5) Sculpture
- 6) Metalwork
- 7) Woodwork
- 8) Pottery / Porcelain
- 9) Glass
- 10) Jewelry
- 11) Fiber Arts (Fabric, Weaving, and Leather)
- 12) Mixed Media / Other

Application/Jury Process:

Artists who participated in Art Waddle 2019 are automatically accepted (with 50% jury fee) but need to complete the application process. All new entries can submit Website, Facebook or Instagram information for jury verification, or three pictures. No un-juried or commercial side products allowed. Response/turn-around time will be within 48 hours. Artists must be 18 years of age to participate.

Staff Support:

Staff will be present on site throughout the entire Waddle schedule of events Friday and Saturday. Contact information will be posted.

Set-up:

Artists can set up Friday with advance approval of the Event Director and from their host location. Saturday set up will begin at 8:30 am – 10am show opening. Vehicles must be moved to designated artist parking areas by that time. Tear down will be at 4pm on Saturday. Absolutely no early staging of cars and trailers due to residential and business operations are permitted.

Artist parking:

We have assigned specific parking areas for artists with or without trailers near their respective locations. Anyone needing shuttle assistance can call our staff hotline for assistance.

Artist Equipment:

We suggest all artists have a canopy since areas may not be fully shaded along with the necessary tables and chairs for their booths. Artists are responsible for bringing any equipment necessary to display their art along with appropriate tie downs or weights (25lbs per leg suggested).

Accommodations:

We have chosen The Kendall Inn and The Bevy Hotel for their historical and artistic nature respectively, both of which are offering discounted rates to Waddle participants as well as Waddlers coming in for the weekend. There are also many B & B's and other motels in the area available for accommodations.

ATMs:

ATMs will be available at various locations for Waddlers and artists convenience.

Port-a-Pots:

Facilities will be located on the event footprint in addition to the City's fixed public bathroom locations. Do not ask to use private resident or merchant bathroom facilities.

Pets:

This is a pet friendly event at outdoor locations and owners are expected to maintain cleanliness after their pet. Excessive barking will not be allowed and may result in asking you to remove your pet.

Covid:

All participants are required to adhere to City of Boerne Covid guidelines in force during event date.

Badges:

Artists will be given badges with lanyards for participant identification and entry into the Artists areas and the ability to receive discounts at the participating merchants.

Security:

Police will be available if required for an emergency on Saturday. No security is being provided on Friday night. If you wish to setup your tents, tables and chairs we cannot be responsible for them; however, we feel that they should be fine at the host locations.

Events Off Main, staff and affiliates, merchants, host locations, the Hill Country Council for the Arts and the City of Boerne accept no liability for any reason monetarily or otherwise for artist's equipment, art works – original or reproduced, vehicles, etc. By signing this application, the artist named below holds harmless all organizations and individuals associated with the Boerne Art Waddle for any reason and agrees to allow the event to use any pictures of artwork or person for use in promotional material media relative to the event.
